RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Eligibility:

Open to Malaysian students who:-

- Are currently attending secondary school in Malaysia;
- Are between the age of 15 and 18 as of 21st April 2018;
- Are not this contest's previous Tokyo prize winner;
- Have not stayed in Japan for a total of 6 months until 21st April 2018;
- Whose mother tongue is not Japanese; and
- Either parent is not a Japanese national.

2. Theme, Length of Speech and Manuscript

- The speech theme is **"The App I Wish to Create..."** but students must create their own appropriate title. The speech must be delivered within 5 minutes' length.
- The manuscript submitted must be the original work of the students and it must not have previously been presented in other contest or event.
- Manuscript may be handwritten or typewritten using the Japanese style manuscript paper (20x20 characters).

3. Procedure

- Each application must be endorsed by:-
 - (a) the school's principal: AND
 - (b) the student's legal guardian.
- Only ONE application from each school will be accepted.

- Students must submit their original manuscript together with the completed application form and a passport-sized photo to the respective secretariats:-

(a) Public School Learners (Those who learn Japanese Language at Public School)

(b) Private Learners (Those who learn Japanese Language outside the Public School)

Secretariat : The Japan Foundation, Kuala Lumpur

Closing Date : 5th March 2018

4. Travel Allowance

Contest finalists (and one accompanying teacher or legal guardian) will be given travelling allowances and a night hotel accommodation (twin sharing), if they are from outside Kuala Lumpur, Selangor (except Sabak Bernam), Putrajaya or Seremban and Labu (Negeri Sembilan).
