Ms. Noor Asyhikin was one of four Malaysian participants for East Asia Future Leader Programme (Youth Exchange), with the theme of "Environment: Symbiosis with Nature, and a Sustainable Society" held 3 to 16 of June 2008 in Japan. Three other participants were Mr. Eugene Cheah Ewe Jin (Kota Kinabalu Wetland Centre), Mr. Sinor Rafliz Musa (Wetlands International, Malaysia) and Ms. Julia Ng Su Chen (TRAFFIC Southeast Asia).

The six and a half hour journey in Malaysia Airlines flight MH088 to Narita didn't even felt that long. I was more excited and extremely happy that night, thinking about the upcoming fourteen days that I am about to face. Being chosen as one of the representative from Malaysia for East Asia Future Leader Programme (Youth Exchange) I surely cannot hid my tremendous happy and thrilled feelings.

300 words cannot elucidate the experience and lessons that I gained during my golden trip in Japan from 3rd to 16th June 2008. From the basic experience of eating original Japanese cuisines to the formal meetings with the leaders in Japan such as Mr Osamu Uno, the Vice Minister for Foreign Affair. our lunches, the bus drivers, the shopkeepers and in short almost all Japanese people were very very nice. Although we had some difficulties in communication but the Japanese never failed to do their best to ensure that we feel comfortable and secure. I was really touched with their efforts especially in making me and some other Muslims friends to be contented with the foods they served and also in general, their efforts in making the entire participant satisfy and feel like home throughout this programme.

I could write pages about my trip, unfortunately there is a limit. But I would like to express here my heartfelt and sincere thanks to the Japan Foundation, Japan Government, the coordinators, the tourist guides, all NGOs/NPOs that participated, the schools and university that participated, my lovely home stay family, and those whom I didn't mentioned here. ## Wagashi Demonstration and Workshop



For the first time ever, JFKL organized a workshop and demonstration on Wagashi, which was held at Hotel Nikko Kuala Lumpur on 2 July 2008. 3 experts of wagashi, Mr. Yamaguchi Kenji, Mr. Shibutani Hiroshi and Mr. Hirata Teruo were dispatched from Matsue-gashi Association, Shimane Prefecture, Japan for the one-day workshop. Participants were introduced with three basic techniques in wagashi making - bake, boil, and steam - based on three different types of wagashi. About 120 participants had the opportunity to observe and experience the wagashi making process at both morning and evening sessions. His Excellency Ambassador Horie Masahiko made a remark during closing ceremony and everyone was served with wagashi and maccha at the end of each session. Participants really enjoyed the experience to make and taste the authentic wagashi and hope for more wagashi workshops in the future.









# Japanese Kite Workshop by JFKL at Festival in Kangar

Japan Festival was held for the first time in Kangar, Perlis on 20 July 2008. The event was organized by Consulate General of Japan at Penang and Perlis State Government, in collaboration with JFKL. 








## **JFKL New Location Map**
