2017 Japanese Skit Contest for University and College Students

Contest Guidelines

1. Eligibility

Participating team members must be:

- A current student at a university/ college in Malaysia at the time of application.
- A non-native Japanese speaker whose neither parents is a Japanese.

2. Participation

The team should have not more than ten (10) members, including both cast and crew.

3. Video, Theme and Manuscript

- (a) Video must be **not more than 10 minutes length**.
- (b) Theme: '**60**' – The video must clearly depict this theme and the creative use of Japanese language to portray this message across.
- (c) Manuscript submitted must be the original work of the team and has not been presented in any contest or event before. The manuscript **MUST** be handwritten or typewritten in Japanese language or "Romaji".
- (d) Entry Forms will be made available for download on JFKL website www.jfkl.org.my/events/2017-skit-contest/
- (e) The Japan Foundation, Kuala Lumpur reserves the rights to all entries received.

4. Procedure

- (a) **Skit Videos** must be **uploaded on YouTube** through the team's account as an "unlisted" video. Video that is set "Public" under Privacy Settings is not accepted.
- (b) All Videos have to be uploaded on YouTube. Manuscripts together with the completed Entry forms must be submitted **by e-mail** to nihongo@jfkl.org.my by the date line **31 October 2017**.

5. Results

Judges' decision is final. The announcement of the result of the contest will be posted on The Japan Foundation, Kuala Lumpur's website in December 2017.

The 1st Prize winning team leader will attend the 2018 Japanese Language Festival in order to claim their prizes and certificates, as well as delivering a short presentation of their winning skit, at a date and venue to be advised later.

6. Costs

All costs incurred for the contest participation shall be borne by the Team.
