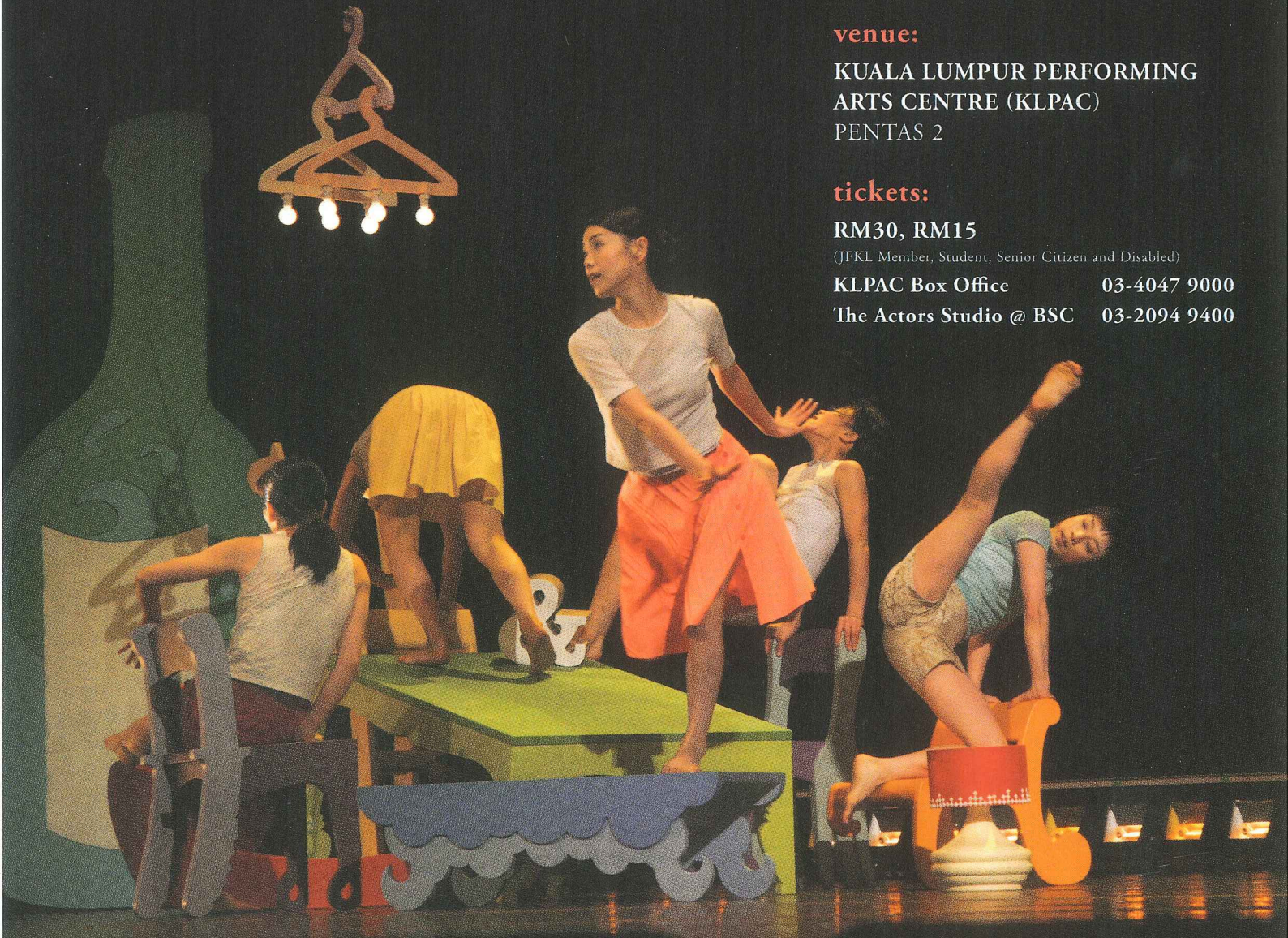

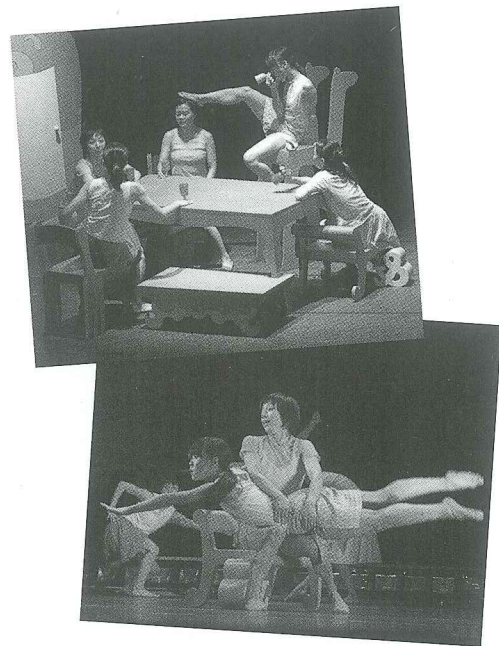
“a super-cute dance show!”

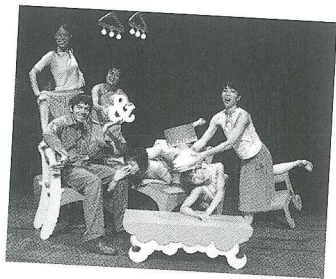


Strange Kinoko Dance Company (Japan)

Established in 1990, Strange Kinoko Dance Company is an all-female dance company whose unique "pop, girly and physical" style has been attracting audiences in Japan and abroad. One of their masterpieces, "Frill (mini)" received the Japan Dance Critics Association's "New Artist Award" and the Grand Prize at the Japan Internet Performing Arts Awards. In 2004, they performed their piece "Flower-Picking" to an audience of over 7,000 at the open-air theatre in Stockholm, Sweden.

Justin Caleo (Set Designer, Australia)

Justin is a full-time artist based in Melbourne, Australia. A graduate of RMIT University in Melbourne, Justin studied arts in Mexico, Vietnam and Australia, and has participated in numerous exhibitions, including the Design Biennale in France.

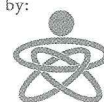
