

The 16th International Conference on Japanese Language Education in Malaysia Submission Guidelines

Organized by The Japan Foundation Kuala Lumpur, Ambang Asuhan Jepun Universiti Malaya and Malaysian Japanese Language Instructors Society (MAJLIS), the conference provides a venue for Japanese language teachers and researchers in Malaysia and abroad to share findings of their researches and experience with their peers.

This year, 2019, the conference will be held on October 5 (Sat.) at University of Malaya. The organisers wish to invite interested paper presenters and exhibitors to submit proposals for the oral / poster presentation and Teacher's Corner (アイデア広場) respectively.

Should you be applying for both poster/oral presentation and Teacher's Corner at the same time, their content must NOT be the same. Please note that the closing date for the poster/oral presentation and the Teacher's Corner is not the same.

ORAL/POSTER PRESENTATION

1. Submission Qualification

Those who are related and have interest in the Japanese language education in Malaysia are invited to submit their proposal paper.

2. Conference Paper

Researches and practices that are related and considered beneficial to the development of the Japanese language education in Malaysia; and have not been presented elsewhere will be considered. Interim reports are also welcomed.

3. Presentation Category

There are two (2) categories, namely Oral and Poster Presentation.

	Category	Features	Duration
1	Oral Presentation	Time allocated includes Q & A session Equipment such as notebook may be used.	30 mins <i>Presentation: 20 mins, Q & A: 10 mins</i>
2	Poster Presentation	Posters to be pasted within the board (76cm x 139cm - about 12 pieces of A4 sized paper) There will be direct interactions with participants such as Q & A and exchange of viewpoints. Equipment such as notebook may be used but electricity supply will NOT be provided.	40 mins <i>Free Format</i>

4. Language Medium

Papers may be presented in Japanese, English or Malay.

5. Application Procedure

Register online by completing the form at <https://form.jotform.me/jldjfk/PR16> and submit together with: -

a) A Proposal (for the purpose of screening)

Free format.

The length of the proposal should be within one A4-sized paper. It is to be written in the

same language used for its presentation at the conference. The proposal should include: -

- i. Title of the paper (please include English title if your proposal is in Japanese or Malay)
- ii. Objective and background of the research/practice
- iii. Content of the research/practice
- iv. Summarized findings or result

b) A Summary (for the purpose of publicity)

It will be uploaded onto JFKL website for the conference's publicity, once the proposal has been accepted. The summary should be written in the same language used for its presentation at the conference. It should include:-

- i. Title of the paper (please include English title if the proposal is in Japanese or Malay)
- ii. Name of presenter(s)
- iii. Outline of the paper (Japanese: 400 characters, English or Malay: 200 words)
- iv. Name of the presenter's institution or organization

6. Closing Date for Application

July 28, 2019 (Sunday)

7. Visual Recording Copyrights

The organisers reserve the rights to use any photographs and videos taken at the conference and during the paper presentations for publicity purposes, such as but not limited to, organisers' webpage, reports and newsletters.

9. Proposal Screenings

All submitted proposals will go through the blind review process. Once the result has been confirmed by the conference committee, the applicants will be notified. Decision of the committee is final and no further enquiries will be entertained.

The committee may propose changes to the title or content of the paper for the accepted papers or impose conditions for the paper to be accepted.

10. Paper

Accepted papers will be published in the conference's website. The papers have to conform to the following requirement and be submitted to the organisers by **September 15, 2019 (Sunday)**.

- a) There is no fixed format.
- b) The length of the 'paper' (inclusive of diagrams) should be of: -
 - 2-4 pages of A4-sized paper for oral presentation
 - 1-2 pages of A4-sized paper for poster presentation
- c) It should be written in the same language used for its presentation at the conference.
- d) The paper should include: -
 - i. Title (please include English title if the proposal is in Japanese or Malay)
 - ii. Name of presenter(s)
 - iii. Objective and background of the research/practice
 - iv. Content of the research/practice
 - v. Findings or result
 - vi. References
