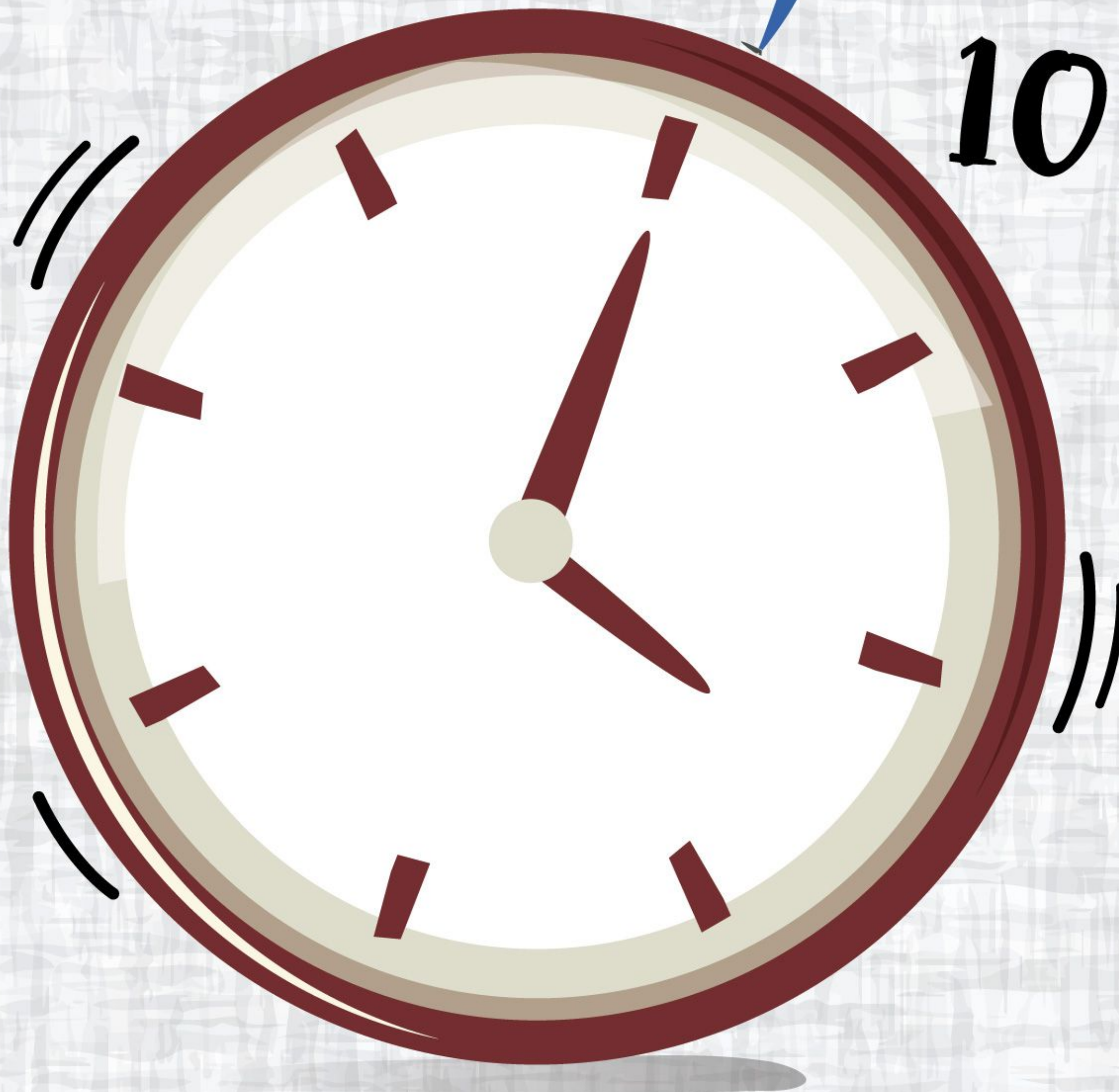

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Eligibility:

Open to Malaysian students who are:-

- Currently attending secondary school in Malaysia.
- Between the age of 15 and 18 as of 20th April 2019.
- Not this contest's previous 1st prize winner.
- Have not stayed in Japan for a total of 6 months until 21st July 2019.
- A non-native Japanese speaker (mother tongue is not Japanese).
- Both parents are not Japanese nationals.

2. Theme, Length of Speech and Manuscript

- The speech theme is "**Me, after 10 years...**"
- Contestants should choose a suitable title for their speech.
- The length of each speech must be within 5 minutes.
- Manuscript must be typewritten using the Japanese style manuscript paper (20x20 characters).

3. Procedure

- The contest is divided into 2 categories, namely:-
 - Public School Learners (Those who learn Japanese Language at Public School); and
 - Private Learners (Those who learn Japanese Language outside the Public School).
- Only online applications are accepted for both categories of the contest. Incomplete application will be rejected.
- Each application must be endorsed by:-
 - the school's principal AND
 - the student's legal guardian.
- No restrictions on number of application from each school.
- Contest details, contest Rules & Regulations, Eligibility Check Sheet, How to upload video on YouTube, How to Unlisted and Japanese style manuscript paper may be downloaded from The Japan Foundation, Kuala Lumpur website at the following link: <http://www.jfkl.org.my/events/jsc2019/>
- Students are to complete the google form (<https://goo.gl/iZUCBU>) and submit them online by **28 February 2019**, together with: -
 - The link of the video of their speech uploaded on YouTube;

 - Completed Contest's Eligibility Form endorsed by their parent and school principal; and
 - A recent passport-size photo.

4. Travel Allowance

Contest finalists (and one accompanying teacher or legal guardian) will be given travelling allowances and a night hotel accommodation (twin sharing), if they are from outside Kuala Lumpur, Selangor (except Sabak Bernam), Putrajaya or Seremban and Labu (Negeri Sembilan).
